

Family Planning Annual Report (FPAR 2.0)

Demographic Question Guide

Encounter level data is required for every family planning patient and physician and nurse visit (including, pregnancy test, emergency contraception, supply visit, method problem, etc.) either face-to-face in a Title X service site or virtual using telehealth technology.

This document provides an overview of demographic questions often ascertained during the registration process that are needed for FPAR 2.0 reporting. All questions are expected to be completed for each encounter.

Sex (at birth)

- Male
- Female

Gender Identity *this question may be done during the clinical visit, the location varies with EHR vendor

- Male
- Female
- Female-to-Male (FTM)/Transgender Male/Trans Male
- Male-to-female (MTF)/Transgender Female/Trans Woman
- Other
- Identifies as neither exclusively male nor female
- Choose not to disclose
- Unknown

Birth Date

Race

- American Indian or Alaska Native
- Asian
- Black or African American
- Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander
- White
- Unknown

Ethnicity

- Not Hispanic/Latino
- Hispanic

Limited English Proficiency: Refers to family planning users who do not speak English as their primary language and who have a limited ability to read, write, speak, or understand English.

Annual Household Income: Annual income total of patient's household.

Family Size: Must be 1 (the patient) or greater
